Wings Wildlife Park

Tasmania is known for rolling English style countryside and of course the "Tassie Devil". Today you'll travel through the picturesque countryside and visit with the Tasmanian Devil at Wings Farm Park. Wings Park is a massive reserve with an impressive array of native Australian animals. See Emu's and get close to free roaming kangaroos.

Visit with the Tasmanian Devil and other native animals at Wings Wildlife Park. The park houses the largest collection of wildlife in Tasmania including birds of prey, koala, kangaroos, reptiles, rodents and an assortment of trout and salmon. It also features a farm with crops and cattle. See the efforts made to protect and preserve the animals at the park's nursery.



Gunns Plains

Visit the beautiful countryside of Gunn Plains, go beneath the farmlands of Gunns Plains to one of Tasmania's earliest limestone cave reserves. You'll descend 54 steep steps to a lit pathway that reveals an underground world of sparkling crystals, beautiful rock formations and glow worms dangling from silk threads. This unique and unforgettable underground world will amaze you.

On the return drive you'll take a brief tour through Burnie and learn about Tasmania's "Gateway to the North".

- **Wildlife Encounter:** Get closer to free roaming kangaroos and other unique native Australian lovely animals at Wings Wildlife Park.
- **Gunns Plains Caves Discovery:** See interesting rock formations, glow worm displays.
