Award-winning Merimbula oysters have become famous throughout Australia and the world for their excellent quality and flavour.</p> <p>Nothing come close to Sydney Rock Oysters from the pristine waters of Sapphire Coast. Today, enjoy a delicious lunch with an array of sweet and savoury offerings held at a historic cocktail lounge.
