

Port Arthur

A visit to Tasmania isn't complete without touring the site of one of Australia's most infamous prisons, the World Heritage-listed Port Arthur. Separated from Tasmania by a narrow neck of land, Port Arthur was once known as the "inescapable prison", housing hardened criminals subject to harsh punishment. Today, the convicts and guards are gone, but the stories – set in an equally dramatic landscape of craggy cliff faces and the remains of more than 30 buildings still remain.

Tasmanian Devil Unzoo



Eaglehawk Neck

Go wild during this engaging half-day adventure that starts with a narrated journey up the gorgeously lush Tasman Peninsula to reach Tasmanian Devil Unzoo, the world's first Tasmanian devil centre. Here, observe these unique black-and-white marsupials as they snarf, snarl and feed, an aggressive and entertaining activity to behold. Wander amongst wallabies, hand-feed friendly kangaroos, observe quolls and falcons and meet a Potoroo, a kangaroo-rat-like creature. Before leaving, visit the gift shop for mementos, including local wines.

Tasmania is renowned for wild and rugged landscapes and dramatic coastal scenery. You'll uncover breath-taking views and convict history on this tour of the Tasman Peninsula and Eaglehawk Neck. First stop on the tour is Eaglehawk Neck where you can view a unique rock formation, tessellated pavement. This area is also a significant site in convict history – you'll see the Officer's Quarters and 'The Dog Line' where savage dogs once guarded the isthmus to prevent convicts escaping from Port Arthur. Depending on conditions, next stop is Devil's Kitchen or Tasman Arch, both marvels of nature where over the years, softer layers of rock has been eroded by the waves, leaving the stronger top layers withstanding. Continue on to see the dramatic Blow Hole. The final stop on the tour is Pirates Bay Lookout and the view is stunning. From here you'll have views over the beautiful white sand beach, blue water and rugged rocky cliffs.

- Tasmanian Devil Unzoo: Explore the secrets of Tasmanian devils Unzoo and learn more about their lifestyles and their difficulties faced.

Coal Mines

Enjoy the combination of the wonders of the Tasman Peninsula coast line & life and the fascinating convict history of Australia with this tour.
